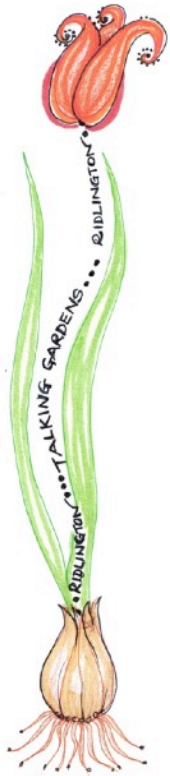


Talking Gardens Update
